Think Twice

Cedar Park is currently observing **TWO DESIGNATED DAYS PER WEEK** watering restrictions.

Lake Travis is Cedar Park's water source and Cedar Park remains committed to water conservation.

See what is prohibited and allowed in the section to the right.

Prohibited

- Water waste (includes off-schedule sprinkler watering, excessive runoff, controllable leaks, and more).

Visit waterthriftycedarpark.org to view all restrictions.

Allowed

- Irrigation/sprinklers (two designated days per week, before 10 a.m. and after 7 p.m.)
- Hand watering (anytime)
- Drip/soaker hose (anytime)
- Filling of pools (anytime)
- Pressure washing (must have spray nozzle that uses no more than 3.5 gallons of water per minute and employs a working trigger shut-off with a protective weep mechanism)
- Extended landscape variances (one 21-day variance granted per installation)
- Residential and charity car washing (on any day using a nozzle or hose-end with automatic shut-off capabilities)
- Decorative water features
